Who is Busing on the Lookout?

Busing On the Lookout (BOTL) fights human trafficking by working with public transit and school transportation to "look out" for trafficking victims and spread awareness about human trafficking.

Human trafficking is a crime where a person manipulates or takes advantage of someone else so they will work for them or have sex for money. Anyone under the age of 18 that exchanges sex for money or other things of value is considered a victim of human trafficking.

What is the BOTL Youth on Transportation Survey?

BOTL wants to know the best ways to share information about human trafficking with youth. The BOTL Youth on Transportation Survey:

- Is for youth ages 13-24.
- Has 18 questions covering use of transportation, knowledge of human trafficking and what an awareness campaign for youth should include.
- Should take around 10-20 minutes to complete.
- Will be 100% anonymous and confidential.

BOTL will use survey responses to help inform the development of youth-focused human trafficking awareness materials that will be displayed on public transportation, at bus shelters and stations and in other places youth frequent in communities across the United States. Responses will also help BOTL and our community transportation partners better understand how we can protect youth on transportation.
